The national website of the American Guild of Organists, agohq.org, offers many resources to its members. In this space, a different resource or tool will be highlighted each month.

Are you searching for a new position? One benefit of your membership in the guild is access to an extensive list of positions, both large and small, that are available across the country. To use this resource, go to Agohq.org, and login as a member. Then choose "Find a Job." The list is searchable by job title or state. I recommend searching by state, since job titles have so many variations. The search results will provide a thumbnail description of the opening and a link to more detailed information. This tool is useful even for local searches. When we are notified of positions in the area, we do announce them in the monthly newsletter, but also encourage the institution to list their position on the national website.
